The national consultation in Mongolia was led by the youth and focused on raising awareness of the global education agenda, highlighting the principles of a human rights approach to education, and pin pointing key initiatives to ensuring equal learning opportunities in Mongolia.

Participants, led by the Teacher's Trade Union Youth Committee, identified 5 key priorities in planning for the post-2015 education agenda -

1. Inclusive education for children, youth, and people with disabilities.
2. Non-discriminatory, equitable education for all.
3. Improving quality of education.
4. Quality teachers.
5. Knowledge and skills to participate fully in society and in the workplace.
